### Information and Communication Technology (ICT) Levy

A compulsory annual ICT Levy of \$450 for years 9 & 12; and \$500 for years 7, 8, 10 & 11 for each student. This contributes towards the hiring of the student's laptop devices, software licensing, broadband charges, printing and infrastructure necessary for the delivery of quality education using digital technology across the College. The ICT Levy does not cover non-warranty laptop repairs. If there is any damage to a laptop that is not covered under warranty, a repair charge of up to \$250 will apply.

### Discounts

A sibling discount is offered to families with more than one child enrolled at Assumption College concurrently. The following discounts apply to tuition fees or combined boarding and tuition fees:

- 2<sup>nd</sup> child 10%
- 3<sup>rd</sup> child 25%
- 4<sup>th</sup> and subsequent children 50%



An early payment discount of \$500 is applicable if the total annual fees are paid in full by **March 31<sup>st</sup> 2026**.

### Special Circumstances

Where special and difficult circumstances exist, parents are invited to discuss these with the Principal or Finance Manager with a view to lessening the financial burden incurred from choosing a Catholic Education.

If a family has a valid means-tested concession card, you can apply for CSEF (Camps, Sports and Excursion Fund) payment which can be allocated toward your fee balance.

### Additional Charges That May Apply

- Elective subject material charges – there may be additional charges for materials needed for individual projects during the year.
- Photocopying/text book fee – may apply in lieu of purchasing textbooks, refer to appropriate booklist.
- Lost library book – replacement cost of books not returned at the end of each term (reversed upon return of book).
- Damage to school/boardings house – applied after parents notified.
- Instrumental music – applies only to students undertaking this co-curricular activity.
- Electrical tagging fee – charge for testing of each electrical device in the Boarding Houses.
- Laptop repair (non-warranty) – damage repair charge of up to \$250.
- Laptop not returned to the College upon laptop lease expiry or when student leaves the College – charge of up to \$1,500 will apply.

As far as is practicable, the above fees and charges cover the supply of compulsory excursions/incursions/activities and most classroom requirements. Parents are liable to cover the costs of uniforms and booklist items.

Charges relating to non-compulsory activities may be made throughout the year. Charges will be made based on participation in these activities and will not be applied to the school fee account, e.g. Year 12 graduation, French Exchange, various immersions and interschool events. These activities require payment in advance. Payment instructions will be provided on relevant documentation sent by the College.

Where students are enrolled in VET/VCAL subjects conducted by an external institution, the College will not pass on a charge. If a student does drop out of VET, this can only be done at the end of semester one and will incur a fee that is half of the total cost of the VET course. If a student leaves the College at any point during the year, the course can be transferred and hosted by another school. Under these circumstances the fee will be determined by the proportion of the school year left.

Families using the bus service provided by Assumption College will be billed separately to tuition fees.

Please note that a **one term fee in lieu of notice** will be applied if students leave the College without prior notice. Prior notice period is one term.
